

## 42nd Annual Renaissance Jamboree

Dear 2022 Renaissance Jamboree Non-Profit Participant:

The Town of Bloomsburg, Bloomsburg University, CGA Inc.'s Program Board, Downtown Bloomsburg Inc. and the Columbia Montour Chamber of Commerce are pleased to sponsor the *2022 Renaissance Jamboree* from 10:00 am to 5:00 pm on Saturday, April 30, 2022. Join the thousands of visitors as the event hosts crafters, service organizations, musicians and other performers.

**Due to the East Street Paving project, this year's festival has been moved to Ft. McClure Boulevard near the Bloomsburg Town Park in the south end of town. This road will be closed to traffic and be the site of the arts and craft show and sale.**

As in past years, service agencies and non-profit organizations may sell food and conduct games.

The event will be held rain or shine. Free parking with shuttle service is provided from the Bloomsburg Fairgrounds.

### **2022 BOOTH RESERVATIONS:**

Complete the ON-LINE application and space payment fee. Spaces are \$25.00 per space and are limited to 2 per non-profit. Returning your registration form before the deadline of March 18 does not guarantee you a space. If awarded a space, you will receive an email **no later than March 25, 2022.**

## **PLEASE READ THESE SHOW RULES**

- 1. There are no power outlets available on Ft. McClure Boulevard  
We will allow gasoline or diesel-powered generators THIS YEAR ONLY!**

**Vendors will not be allowed to set-up their spaces until the completion of marking of all assigned spaces by the committee members or 8:00 am at the latest. Do not plan to set-up your display or put items on street before that time.** If you attempt to do this, you may not be invited back next year.

- 3. Do not leave your vehicle unattended.** Someone should be available at all times to move the vehicle during the set-up period should it be necessary. Please be patient during this hectic period and **do not block the road.** The road needs to be clear for **emergency reasons.** Any vehicle illegally parked will receive a ticket and/or towed at owner's expense. All vehicles must be unloaded and moved **off the venue site by 9:00 am.** People usually start attending the event a little before 10 am. Parking is available in vendor designated sections of Ft McClure Boulevard and the Bloomsburg Fairgrounds. A map of parking will be provided to you.

- 4. Renaissance Jamboree ends at 5:00 pm. Do not plan to breakdown your display before that time.** Vendors are responsible for **cleaning up** their assigned area. Materials used should be recyclable or biodegradable. **No open charcoal, wood fires, or trailers over 18ft. are permitted.**

**Note: Spaces are 22' long by 10' deep.**

5. **“No Show” or those vendors who leave early might not be eligible to participate at next year’s Renaissance Jamboree.** Renaissance committee members will check to make sure all spaces are filled.
  
6. If your non-profit organization has joined together **with a commercial vendor**, someone from your organization must be present at the booth at all time during show hours. We recommend that if you use a commercial vendor that the commercial vendor donate a minimum of 25% of the gross sales to your organization. **A sign showing *both the commercial vendor’s name and your organization name must be displayed at eye level.* Also, the Commercial Vendor information must be completed in full if you are using a Commercial Vendor.**
  
7. **No animals of any kind will be permitted at Renaissance Jamboree.** Please do not bring your pets or you will be asked to remove your pet from the festival area.

We look forward to the **Spring of 2022** and another successful Renaissance Jamboree. We hope that you will join us in the festivities.
